Recyclables (4 sorts required)

- Green/brown glass bottles
 - food or beverage only
- Clear glass bottles
 - food or beverage only



NO window glass, light bulbs, mirrors, dish-ware, or ceramics

- Plastic bottles & containers
 - Food, drink, household products, etc.
 - Dairy, produce, bakery deli



NO 5 gal. pails, plastic bags, plant pots, motor oil bottles, laundry baskets

Aluminum bottles & cans
Empty aerosol cans
Steel, tin, bi-metal cans



- Newspaper, magazines, mixed paper, cardboard, cereal, & other box board



NO food-contaminated paper, tissue pa-per, or wax coated cardboard
